Off-track camps can be scheduled too! Get a group of your friends together for your own riding camp! Camps fill up quickly and are limited to 8 students per session. A minimum of 4 campers is required to hold a camp. (camp dues subject to change)

The cost of each Camp is \$425 for the five-day session. This includes daily riding lessons, daily lectures and demonstrations, a starter grooming kit and T-shirt.



Please send this registration form along with a nonrefundable \$100.00 deposit, to Helicon Show Stables (address at the top of this flier). We will then send you an email confirming your camper's spot. Please note that a space is not reserved until you send the deposit and receive confirmation.

Helicon Show Stables offers riders (or wanna-be-riders), from the age of six and over a unique opportunity to learn all facets of hunt seat riding and horsemanship; including grooming, saddling, stable management, horse care, feeding, and basic veterinary and farrier care. The camps are individualized and intensive due to the limited enrollment per session. All students will be under the training and supervision of the professional staff at Helicon Show Stables. Camps are offered throughout the year to fit in with any school track schedule. Indoor riding arena allows year-round riding!

Participants need to be at camp daily at 9:00 am and picked up promptly at 3:00 pm, Monday through Friday. Campers should pack a lunch, water, drinks, snacks, and change for the candy machine (.25). We have a pop/water machine tool (\$1.25). Campers should wear blue jeans, chaps, or riding breeches; paddock boots or riding boots. NO TENNIS SHOESI Riding helmets with safety harnesses are always required—we have some to use at Helicon Show Stables, although it is best to buy your own if you continue to ride.
